Contest deadline: June 1, 2022. Entries will be narrowed down to the top five and then displayed at our annual Power to the Park Event on Saturday June 25 where we will invite the public to vote on their favorite design.

Prizes:

- First place design winner will receive \$100 cash
- The 4 runner ups chosen to have their logos displayed will receive a \$25 cash prize

Logo Contest Guidelines:

- Submissions must be received by June 1, 2022 to be eligible.
- Submissions should be mailed to Powers Park, PO Box 715, Lyndonville, VT 05851 or emailed to powersparkvt@gmail.com.
- Five designs will be selected by an independent board of reviewers to be chosen as the Final Contestants on June 8.
- Final contestants will be announced/notified June 13 and their design will be placed on display for voting on June 25 at the annual Power to the Park Event. (More details forthcoming).
- First place winner will win \$100 cash. The 4 runner ups will each receive \$25 cash for their entry.
- The contest is open to the public and anyone wanting to help contribute to a safe place to recreate and increase park awareness.
- A maximum of one entry per person will be allowed.
- Submissions must be able to be reproducible for print materials, t-shirts and other media-related items.
- Winner and final runner ups agree to have their name and school affiliation available to media release.
- Village Improvement Society/Powers Park reserves the right to use any submitted image in advertising and/or promotion it deems suitable, on its website and social media.
- Entries must be original work submitted by the person submitting the entry form, affirming their work is their own and has not been copied in part or whole from any other work or individual that may claim ownership of the image
- Entries should represent the uniqueness of Powers Park and the diversity of activities and recreation the park allows. Winning entries will demonstrate a creative, unique design with quality focus.
- Judging of entries will be done by a panel of judges selected by the Powers Park Board. The name of the entrant will not be disclosed to the panel of judges. Selection of winners will be based on appeal, ease of production/reproduction and skill.
- Electronic entries should be submitted in JPEG or TIFF formats and not to exceed 25 MB.
